Note:

1. For Bioengineering and Bioengineering, GATE and GPAT scores were normalized using the highest score obtained by the candidates in both exams separately.
2. For Data Science and Artificial Intelligence, a composite score was calculated based on 70% weightage on GATE score and upto 30% weightage on GATE discipline (30% for CS&DA, 25% for ECE and 15% for others).
3. For Mechatronics Engineering, a composite score was calculated based on 70% weightage on GATE score and 5% for 10th marks, 10% per 12th marks and 15% for BTech/Msc marks.
